Steeple Cross Financial Update Back in 2023, Session decided to move forward with a new cross for our steeple. The \$61,332 project was paid for mostly through Unspecified Memorials and the Henderson Fund, at \$25,000 each, with the remaining \$11,332 from the Building Fund. Session asked the congregation to contribute memorials and honorariums through which we received approximately \$6000, which will partially replenish the amount that was used from the Building Fund. The Building Fund currently has \$103,535.15.
